This certified 40-hour instructor course has been taught through Nevada/Colorado/Texas Peace Officers Standards Training Commissions. Arizona C.E.U. credit for law enforcement. Plus this course may be honored by many other states. This Instructors course includes updated use of force, street modified Techniques and material in accordance with legislative and case law for all states.

- The cost of the full 5 day instructor course is \$495 / \$295 for re-certifying and advanced instructors.
- Every 4 officers from same agency a 5th officer receives free scholarship.

Day One

Many attendees are academy instructors therefore the morning session is dedicated to USE OF FORCE procedures and policies, in addition to a condensed block of instruction on instructor development. The intense use of force procedures are re-enforced throughout the next five days.

The afternoon lesson block includes weapons retention, handcuffing, searching, compliant subject come-along and felony arrest procedures and techniques.



Day two

After a test on the previous days training the remainder of the day is dedicated to the third lesson block of take-downs and **Officer Safety Scenarios**.



Day Three

After a test on the previous days training the remainder of the day is dedicated to Self Defense, weapons disarming, ground fighting and deadly force techniques.



Day Four

After a test on the previous days training the morning is dedicated to CQB. The afternoon is student development of **Officer Survival Scenarios**.

Day Five

After a test on the previous days training the morning is dedicated to the final examinations both written and physical. The afternoon is for basic student teaching the course content/examination.

Martial artist may qualify for the same certification as law enforcement plus belt rank with USJJF, USMAF and O.S.S. For those who are unable to attend the full course: **FSS** \$395 these days apply toward eventual Instructor certification or **SS** \$275 Front Line Officers (FLO), Martial Artist; police self defense instructor certification. Groups of (4) to Nine (9) from same school / agency \$895 for **SS**
