Subject: **IF Qualification rules for World Games.**

Dear Sir/Madam,

The Rules of the World Games indicates that World Games competitions are elite competitions which are *“reserved for invited competitors of the highest standard only”*. The IF's are therefore required to select only the top competitors and/or teams in their sports whilst ensuring an adequate global representation of its members.

Recently the IWGA has sent a letter to all NOC's in follow-up to the letter of IOC President Jacques Rogge in February (copy of the letter is attached). In the letter of the IWGA the NOC's are informed on the qualification procedures for participation in World Games events.

I would appreciate if you would inform the IWGA on the following;

- The qualification procedure for each of the sports and/or sports discipline of your federation on the competition programme of World Games 2005 in Duisburg.
- The name, date and place of the international events where competitors can qualify for participation in accordance with the rules of your sport.

You are also requested to inform the IWGA as soon as possible on the results of the qualification in the sports and sports disciplines on the competition programme.
